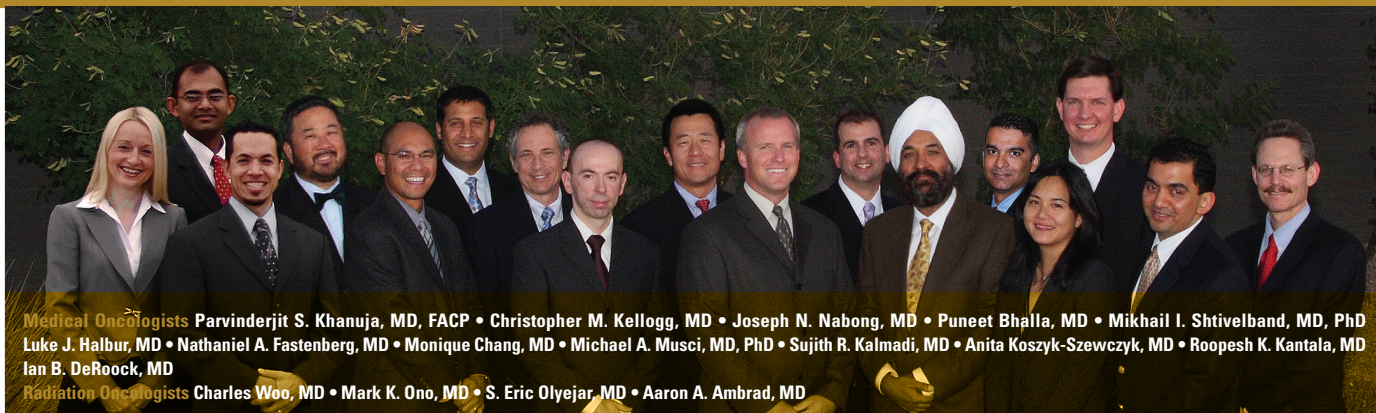

Comprehensive, Customized Cancer Care

The state-of-the-art facilities at ICRC are the first of their kind in the East Valley. Seventeen fellowship-trained specialists offer perspectives from the country's top research and cancer centers.

When you or someone you love is diagnosed with cancer, you want the best care possible, provided by the most highly trained specialists.

In many places around the country, patients travel for hours to receive that level of care, and if their treatment requires weeks of daily therapies, it imposes a hardship on families, disrupts work schedules, and adds unnecessary stress at a time when it's most difficult to handle.

Not so in Arizona's East Valley, where Ironwood Cancer & Research Centers offer four convenient locations, each dedicated to providing top-quality care close to home.

Depth and Breadth

oncologist Christopher Kellogg, MD. "Because we are a research center, we can enroll qualified patients in clinical studies with access to the latest medications and procedures."

Physical healing is only part of ICRC's approach. Additional resources include peer- and doctor-hosted cancer support groups, nutritional counseling,

an Internet Cancer Library and Resource Center, and genetic testing for patients concerned about breast cancer or other hereditary malignancy.

Advanced technology

"ICRC is the first center in the East Valley to offer stereotactic body radiotherapy and stereotactic radiosurgery," informs board-certified radiation oncologist Mark K. Ono, MD.

"These treatments deliver very high doses of radiation in very concentrated areas. Originally used to treat tumors in the head and brain, these approaches are now used to treat cancers in the lungs, liver, and pancreas, as well."

Other advanced treatments include brachytherapy (radioactive seed implants) for breast, prostate, gynecologic, lung, esophageal, and head and neck cancers, Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy, and Image Guided Radiation Therapy.

All of these approaches maximize the radiation dose delivered to cancer cells while minimizing the exposure, and limiting damage, to nearby healthy tissues.

Notes Dr. Ono, "Everything we do at ICRC is directed to ensuring optimal outcomes and improved quality of life for each patient."
